Entry Fee	\$70 Flat Entry fee for one or all four events Entry Fees must be paid in full by January 10, 2020
Entry Deadline	All on-line entries must be completed no later than December 13, 2019
Rules	All Judges must have taken the 2019 USA Gymnastics T210 Annual Update 2017-2020 Rules and age groups will be used at this competition
Concessions	Onsite concession will be provided.
Entry Process	<p>Step 1: Club administrators log on to the USA Gymnastics website and click on Member Services</p> <p>Step 2: Click on Club Administration link located on the left hand side</p> <p>Step 3: From the drop down menu select Meet Reservation</p> <p>Step 4: Click Search For Meet button</p> <p>Step 5: Select the discipline, state to pull a list of available sanctions to enter</p> <p>Step 6: Once list appears, you will click on the select link next to the event you wish to enter</p> <p>Step 7: Complete the information requested on the right hand side of screen Club Abbreviation-enter in the name of your team Club Contact/Email/Phone-provide the name, email and phone of an individual that the meet director may contact with meet specific details. The meet contact must be listed as a club administrator with your club. Click here for instruction on how to add a club administrator. Meet Contact/Email/Phone-provide the name, email and phone number of the professional member ie, coach, that will be responsible for the athletes while participating in the competition. The meet contact must be a current professional member affiliated with your club.</p> <p>Step 8: Proceed to select the athlete and coaches that you wish to reserve a spot in the meet</p> <p>Step 9: Once you have made your selection you will then hit the submit button, review your submission, and hit submit again to finalize the reservation Once the final reservation has been submitted confirmation will be emailed to the club contact, meet contact and the meet director of the event.</p>
Awards	All awards will take place immediately following the flights competition. The athletes will go directly to the awards stand following each event. All awards will be presented immediately, then the athletes may return to staging or go with their parents at that time.
Tentative Schedule	Saturday, January 19, 2020 Once entries are received team sheets will be provided that will show each athletes competition times.
Competition Format	Regular competition will consist of levels 1 - Sr Elite. We will use USA Gymnastics Trampoline and Tumbling 2017-2020 Code of Points. This meet may be used as both mobility and eligibility. Once your athlete has completed all their competition they are free to leave.
Qualification	All athletes who have a current USA Gymnastics membership are eligible to compete. All coaches must have current Pro/Jr Pro membership. Judges AND coaches must have completed the 2019-2020 Annual T210 Program update prior to competition.
Staging	A stretching area will be provided onsite. Please do not send your athletes to staging until their flight time has been called. Seating at the Unity center is very limited, please do not arrive to early.
Results	Results will be posted on site as well as sent to teams at the conclusion of the competition.
Apparel	Remember: Long hair for both boys and girls must be secured close to the head. This means if the hair is long enough to up into a ponytail and if it can be put into a bun then it must be secure with either a bun or braid. No jewelry or hard hair decorations are allowed. New piercings must be removed and may NOT be taped. Attire per the 2017-2020 Code of Points is required for all athletes and coaches. Please inform your athletes of the new rules as of 2017 that undergarments which show from under their apparel will result in a deduction of 0.2 pts from each routine in which the offense occurs.
