<b>Entry Fee</b>	\$75 Flat Entry fee for one or all four events Entry Fees must be paid in full by January 10, 2022 Makes checks payable to RSG Booster. If the event is cancelled due to extenuating circumstances we will refund any fees that are not paid out for supplies, rent etc. All considerations will be made to refund as much of the entry fee as possible.
<b>Late Entries Changes</b>	All entries received after the 12/17/21 will be double. \$10 per change after the 12/17/21 deadline. Entries with incorrect gender or date of birth would be \$10 per event.

<b>Entry Process</b>	Levels 1–Sr. Elite (per competitor) Flat Fee for one or all four events \$75.00 All entries must be done on line using USA Gymnastics competition entry system. Instructions: 1. You must be signed in as a club administrator to register athletes and professional members for this event. 2. Once you are logged on as a club administrator, go to Member Services and click Club Administration on the left toolbar. 3. Click on Meet Reservations 4. Click Search for Meets 5. Filter the Discipline Type to TT and the state to TX. Then click Extreme Winter Classic 2021 6. Fill out information and select each coach and athlete that will be attending the competition along with their level. 7. Confirm all athletes, coaches. Once everything is verified click submit the entries. 8. You will NOT be able to pay for the competition on the website, you will need to send a hard copy of your entry form (printed from the USA Gymnastics website along with payment to Ready Set Go Booster Club – 5828 W. 50th Lubbock Tx 79424
<b>Awards</b>	All awards will take place immediately following each flights competition. Athletes will be marched to an awards area for the flight awards.
<b>Tentative Schedule</b>	Friday, February 4th , Level 8 and above Training 2:00 – 4:00pm Friday, February 4th , Level 8 and above Competition 4:00 – 9:30pm Saturday, February 5th, Level 1 – 7
<b>Competition Format</b>	Competition will use the USA Gymnastics competition format. Regular competition will consist of levels 1 – Sr Elite. We will use USA Gymnastics Trampoline and Tumbling 2022 – 2024 Code of Points. This meet may be used as both mobility and eligibility.
<b>Qualification</b>	All athletes who have a current USA Gymnastics membership are eligible to compete. All coaches must have current Competitive Coach membership.
<b>Staging</b>	Each team may designate one USAG member that may remain in the staging area with their younger team members. Parents are not allowed to stay in staging with their child. The staging area will be located at the back of the arena. There will be an entrance by the concession stand. Please encourage your athletes to not bring shoes, bags or personal belongings to the staging area.
<b>Results</b>	Results will not be posted onsite to ensure that there is no congregating and participants are able appropriately social distance. We will email full results to each team at the end of the competition and will post them on the following website: <a href="http://www.airextremelubbock.com">http://www.airextremelubbock.com</a>
<b>Apparel</b>	Remember: Long hair for both boys and girls must be secured close to the head. This means if the hair is long enough to up into a ponytail and if it can be put into a bun then it must be secure with either a bun or braid. No jewelry or hard hair decorations are allowed. New piercings must be removed and may NOT be taped. Attire per the 2021 – 2024 Code of Points is required for all athletes and coaches.
<b>Health Considerations</b>	For the safety of everyone in attendance we are asking that everyone wear a mask when you are in close proximity to others. We will try to set up the stands were spectators are able to socially distance. We want to be respectful of everyone and keeping everyone healthy.
